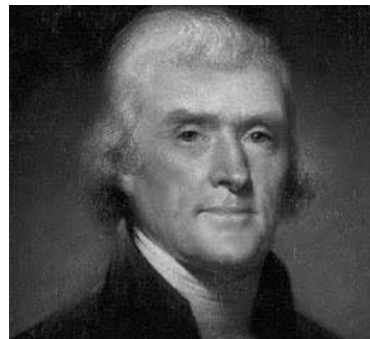

Ask the Attorney

Question: How Do I Know if I am Eligible for Social Security Disability Benefits?

Answer: The only way to know, for sure, if you are eligible for social security disability benefits is to file an application for benefits. Upon receiving your application, the first thing the Social Security Administration will do is look to see if you have acquired enough credits. Credits are based on how much money you have earned while working in a job and paying Social Security Taxes. The credits you earn remain on your Social Security record even if you change jobs or do not have earnings for a while.
